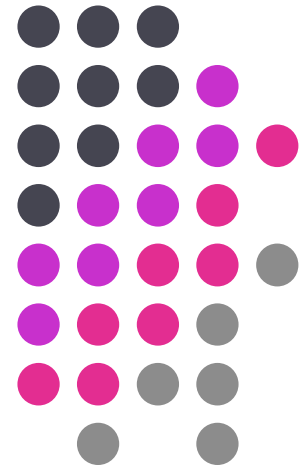

Our Programs

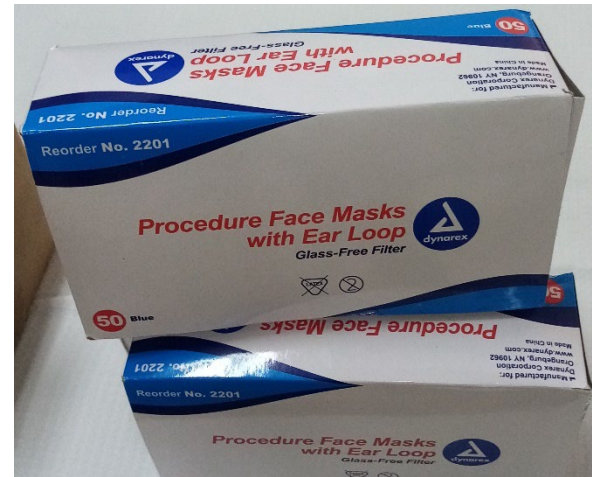
- **Caribbean Health Care (CariHealth) Initiative**

 - Valued at over \$866,000 JMD (~ \$6,000 USD)

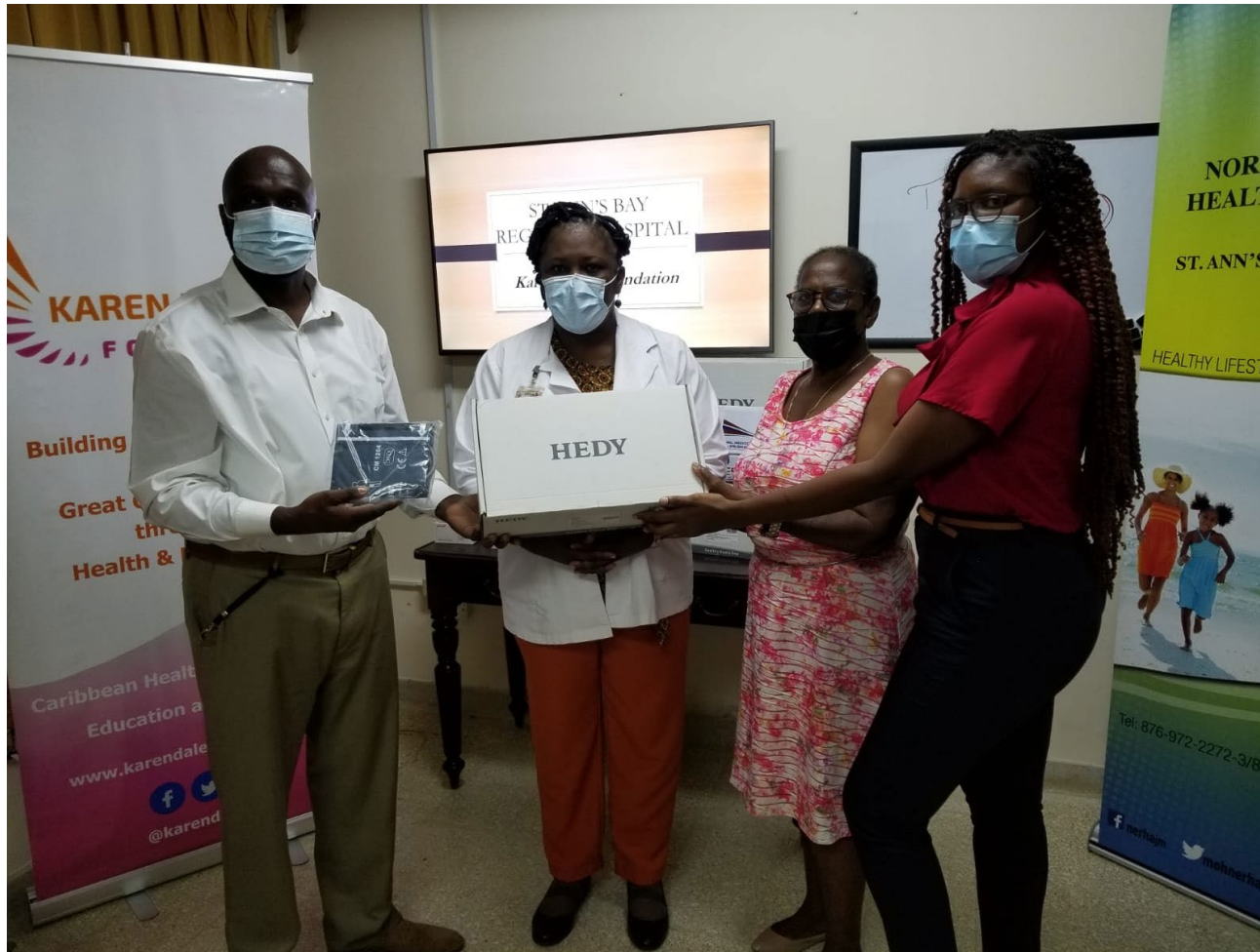

 - Valued at over \$324,000 JMD (~ \$2,100 USD)

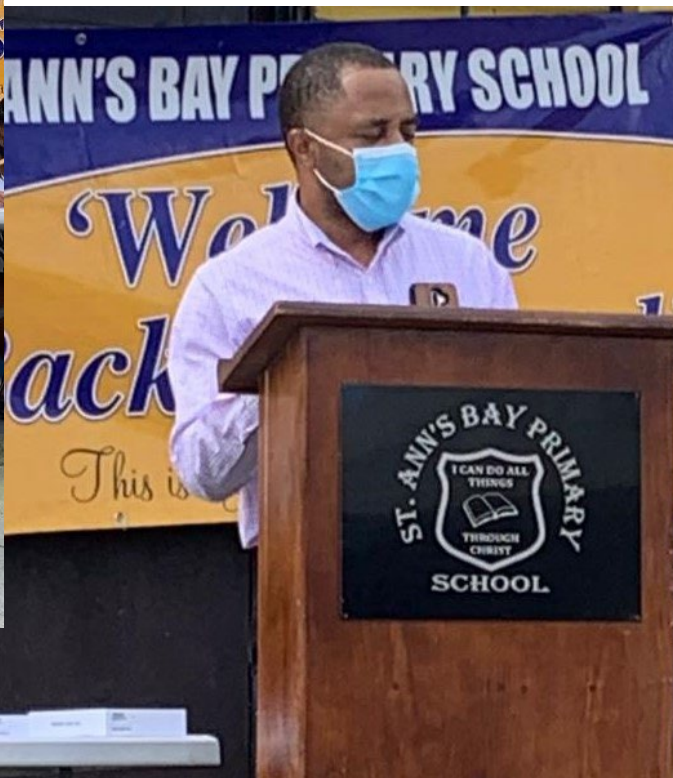
- CariHealth Jamaica Project
 - St. Ann's Bay Regional Hospital (SABRH)
 - Goal for 2024
 - Donation of Medical Equipment & Supplies
 - Patient Ventilator
 - Estimated at \$3,650,250.00 JMD (~ \$24,000 USD)
 - Current Funds Available: \$10,000 USD (42%)

- St. Ann's Bay Primary School, St. Ann, Jamaica
 - 2021
 - Donation of 36 Lenovo Tablets & Cases
 - Donation of Funds to purchase Data Plans
 - Valued at \$4,300 USD (~ \$584,000 JMD)

- Scholarships for High School Seniors in the Charlotte-Area
 - Partnership with the Caribbean International Cultural Association (CICA) since 2020
 - To Date:
 - 7 Scholars
 - \$4,500 USD Awarded

Education and Literacy



- Caribbean High School Scholarship Program
 - Launched June/July 2022
 - Provide support through academic scholarships and mentorship, for Primary School students who need assistance to get to and complete High School
 - Open to graduating St. Ann's Bay Primary School students who are planning to attend High School in the academic year following their graduation

Education and Literacy



- Caribbean High School Scholarship Program
 - Application and Selection Process
 - \$150.00 USD towards Tuition, Fees and School Supplies
 - Each Student per Year throughout their enrollment in High School
 - Academic progress monitored
 - 6 Scholars currently in the Program
 - Goal: Add 4 Scholars each year
